

# HURRICANE IKE CDBG DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS

Liberty County will be taking applications for the housing rehabilitation/reconstruction assistance through the County's recently awarded CDBG Disaster Relief Funds. These funds will assist low to moderate income families who sustained damage from Hurricane Ike and owned and occupied a home at that time.

The County will take applications during the following time periods and locations:

March 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2010 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. 2103 Cos Street, Liberty Texas (Liberty County Courthouse Annex)

March 25<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010 - 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. 207 South Bonham, Cleveland Texas (Public Management, Inc.)

Applicants must meet the following criteria

- For assistance you must have owned and occupied the home during the time of Hurricane Ike, whether you are currently living in the structure, or whether you were displaced because of the storm. (no renters can be assisted)
- Damage to the home must have occurred during Hurricane Ike (provide proof of damage; FEMA assistance document, photos, etc.)
- In order to qualify you must fall below the HUD Section 8 Family Size Income Limits for Liberty County:

- Must be current or have a delinquent tax payment plan on all City and/or County Taxes

Homeowners should bring with them copies of the following items:

- Proof of property ownership ( deed in applicant's name)
- Identification (Driver's License or State issued photo ID)
- Income Verification (SSI award letter, unemployment award letter, etc.)
- FEMA or SBA assistance document for hurricane damage, if available
- Private Insurance assistance document for hurricane damage, if available
- Photos of damages
- Utility bill (water, electric, etc.) for the damaged residence on or before September 13, 2008.

All applicants will be rated based on guidelines and criteria recently passed by Liberty County Commissioners Court.
