MANUAL

Machine trouble

Each machine will prompt when there is trouble.

IF YOUR POLL PAD PRINTER GOES OFF LINE, PRESS THE PAIR BUTTON IN THE BACK OF THE PRINTER. YOU SHOULD SEE A BLUE LIGHT CONFIRMING CONNECTION.

PRINTER MACHINE

- 1. IF it says offline, check your connections
- 2. Follow the prompts to correct errors
- 3. IF you must change the toner, you will most likely have to turn off the machines and reboot... You can try unplugging to see if they will respond.

Verity Scan

1. Follow prompts to correct errors

2. If it says voter over voted, give the option to spoil the ballot or throw out the one race. IF they choose the latter, place the ballot in again and press the CAST ANYWAY button.

Verity Print

- 1. If the print machine freezes, wait about 3 minutes and usually it will continue. If it continues to rotate the printing sign, you may have to reboot. THIS WILL TAKE 5 MINUTES SO MAKE SURE IT IS NECESSARY.
- 2. Always follow the prompts to correct the problem.

WHEN THERE IS AN ISSUE WITH A VOTER OR MACHINE, CALL THE OFFICE FOR CLARIFICATION.



Chain of Custody Form -

- ☐ The authority conducting the election shall provide a chain of custody form that contains the seal numbers on the required equipment/supplies for deployment, and to seal up at night after polls close.
- □ It is recommended that the chain of custody has the seal numbers pre-printed on the form for both



Statement of Residence: (see Texas Election Code 63.0011)

Purpose: To allow voters whose names appear on the list of returned voter registration certificates or who have moved within the county of the election a means to vote and to correct addresses.

How To:

- 1. Provide Statement of Residence Application to the Voter.
- 2. The voter will fill out all required information and return back to the election worker.
- 3. Election worker shall view application and make sure it is filled out completely.
- 4. Presiding Judge files the application to the Voter Registrar in Envelope # 4.
- Scenario 1: Voter is marked suspense on list of registered voters. Voter still lives at address listed on their voter registration record. Voter must complete the Statement of Residence before voting.
- Scenario 2: Voter is marked suspense on list of registered voters. Voter votes in old precinct, if otherwise qualified after signing Statement of Residence. The length of time away from precinct is not a factor.
- Scenario 2: Within the same county, voter moves out of precinct and does not change address to new precinct. Voter votes in old precinct if moved. The voter must sign Statement of Residence before voting and must still live in the political subdivision as previous residence address.
- Scenario 3: If a voter, is surrendering their mail ballot, who is marked suspense on the return list of registered voters, the following items must be completed and returned to the election worker:
 - Surrender their mail ballot
 - fill out the request to cancel application for ballot by mail form, and
 - · statement of residence must be filled out and signed

Oath of Assistance and Interpreter — Follow your Authority of Conducting the Election for proper forms/e-pollbook that may be provided for this step. (see Texas Election Code 63.033, 61.035, 64.0322, 64.034)

Purpose: To provide the oaths that a voter's assistant or interpreter must repeat aloud and sign prior to rendering assistance or interpretation.

How To:

- 1. Administer the **Oath of Assistance** to the Assistant.
- 2. The Assistant must repeat the Oath aloud and complete the form for each voter assisted.
- 3. Instruct the Assistant to:
 - a. Sign the form
 - b. Print his or her name
 - c. Provide his or her address
 - d. Put his or her relationship to the voter in the column
 - e. Indicate whether he or she received or accepted any form of compensation or other benefit

from a candidate, campaign, or political committee for providing assistance to the voter.

4. Presiding Judge files form to the General Custodian Records in Envelope No. 2.

How To:

- 1. Administer the **Oath of Interpreter** to the Interpreter.
- 2. The Interpreter must repeat the Oath aloud.
- 3. Instruct the Interpreter to sign the form.
- 4. Presiding Judge files form to the General Custodian Records in **Envelope No. 2.**
- Scenario 1: Voter who needs assistance in marking his/her ballot. The Assistant must take the appropriate oath prior to rendering assistance.
- Scenario 2: Voter who needs an interpreter. The Interpreter must take the appropriate oath prior to rendering interpreting.
- Scenario 2: All persons except the election judge and clerks must take the oath each time they render assistance or act as an interpreter.
- Scenario 3: The election judge and clerks shall be administered these oaths at the time they take their oath of service prior to the polling place opening.

Notes:

Private Assistants:

Each person, of the voter's choice, who assists the voter in reading or marking his/her ballot must say the Oath of Assistance aloud prior to rendering assistance. An assistant must repeat the oath aloud for each voter whom he/she will assist. The assistant must sign the oath, provide his or her address and relationship to the voter. The assistant must also indicate whether he or she received or accepted any form of compensation or other benefit from a candidate, campaign or political committee in exchange for providing assistance to the voter.

Private Interpreters

Interpreter aloud prior to interpreting for the voter. An interpreter must repeat the oath aloud for each voter for whom he/she will interpret. An interpreter must also sign the Oath of Interpreter. Any person other than the voter's employer, an agent of the voter's employer, or an officer or Agent of a labor union to which the voter belongs may serve as an interpreter. If an interpreter also acts as an assistant to the voter by reading or marking the ballot, the interpreter must also take the Oath of Assistance and sign it before rendering assistance. The Oath of Assistance must also, be fully completed by the interpreter/assistant. If the interpreter is appointed to serve as an interpreter for the voter by an election officer, the interpreter must be a registered voter of the county in which the voter needing the interpreter resides or a registered voter of an adjacent county.

Election Worker Assistants: Election workers may take the Oath of Assistance but are not required to do so.

Election Worker Interpreters: Election workers shall take the Oath of Interpreter at the beginning of the day. This covers all voters to whom election workers will render interpretation.

OATH OF ASSISTANCE

XOath of Person Assisting Voter: "I swear (or affirm) under penalty of perjury that the voter I am assisting represented to me they are eligible to receive assistance; I will not suggest, by word, sign, or gesture, how the voter should vote; I will prepare the voter's ballot as the voter directs; I did not pressure or coerce the voter into choosing me to provide assistance; I am not the voter's employer, an agent of the voter's employer, or an officer or agent of a labor union to which the voter belongs; I will not communicate information about how the voter has voted to another person; and I understand that agent or a woter semployer, or an omicer or agent or a short unto the which me voter belongs; I will not communicate shortmatch about now the voter who is not eligible for assistance, the voter's ballot may not be counted." Reasonable Impediment Declaration — Follow your Authority of Conducting the Election for proper forms/e-pollbook that may be provided for this step. (see Texas Election Code 63.001 (i))

Purpose: Allows voter to vote if voter appears on the official list of registered voters, but does not possess an acceptable form of photo identification under Section 63.0101 (a) of the Texas Election Code and cannot reasonably obtain an Acceptable Photo ID, but the voter presents a supporting form of identification.

This form may also be used if a voter voted provisionally and does not possess and cannot reasonably obtain an acceptable form of photo identification, and appears at the county voter registrar's office within six (6) calendar days after election day to execute a Reasonable Impediment Declaration and present one of the supporting forms of identification, in accordance with Section 65.0541 of the Texas Election Code.

NOTE:

The address on the identification presented is not required to match the address recorded in the official list of registered voters.

NOTE:

If on Election Day, a presented voter registration certificate indicates that the voter is appearing at the incorrect polling place, the voter shall be directed to the correct polling place.

How To:

- 1. Present form to voter, and ask the voter to provide a copy or original of one of the following forms of identification listed in Section 63.0101(b) of the Texas Election Code:
 - a certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or a document confirming birth admissible in a court of law which establishes the voter's identity (which may include a foreign birth document);
 - a current utility bill;
 - a bank statement;
 - a government check;
 - a paycheck; or
 - a government document that shows the voter's name and an address (which includes the voter's voter registration certificate)
- 2. Ask the voter to complete this form by entering their name, and then ask them to review the "Voter's Declaration of Reasonable Impediment", indicate their impediment, and sign their name.
- 3. Ask the voter to return the completed form to you. Neither you nor the election judge may question the voter concerning the reasonableness of any claimed impediment. The election judge shall enter the date and then sign on the space provided on the declaration.
- 4. Either you or the election judge shall fill in the voter's Voter Unique Identification Number ("VUID") in the appropriate box or affix a sticker that contains that information across the box, and note on the combination form that the declaration was used by the voter. Either you or the election judge shall indicate on the "To Be Completed by Election Official" form what type of document the voter provided by checking the appropriate box. Either you or the election judge shall fill in the Date of Election and Location fields.
- 5. Allow the voter to cast a regular ballot.
- 6. Presiding Judge files the form in the General Custodian of Election Records in Envelope No. 2.



REASONABLE IMPEDIMENT DECLARATION

Instructions: If a voter appears on the official list of registered voters, but does not possess an acceptable form of photo identification under Section 63.0101 (a) of the Texas Election Code (which, for voters aged 18-69, has expired by no more than four years, and for voters aged 70 or over, is or is not expired, if otherwise valid) ("Acceptable Photo ID"), and cannot reasonably obtain an Acceptable Photo ID, the following steps shall be taken by the election officer to allow the voter to cast a regular ballot:

- Present this form to the voter, and ask the voter to provide a copy or original of one of the following forms
 of identification listed in Section 63.0101(b) of the Texas Election Code:
 - a. a certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or a document confirming birth admissible
 in a court of law which establishes the voter's identity (which may include a foreign birth document);
 - b. a current utility bill;
 - c. a bank statement;
 - d. a government check;
 - e. a paycheck; or
 - f. a government document that shows the voter's name and an address (which includes the voter's voter registration certificate).

NOTE: The address on the identification presented is not required to match the address recorded in the official list of registered voters.

NOTE: If on Election Day, a presented voter registration certificate indicates that the voter is appearing at the incorrect polling place, the voter should be directed to the correct polling place.

- Ask the voter to complete this form by entering their name, and then ask them to review the "Voter's Declaration of Reasonable Impediment", indicate their impediment, and sign their name.
- Ask the voter to return the completed form to you. Neither you nor the election judge may question the voter concerning the reasonableness of any daimed impediment. The election judge should enter the date and then sign on the space provided on the declaration.
- 4. Either you or the election judge shall fill in the voter's Voter Unique Identification Number ("VUID") in the appropriate box or affix a sticker that contains that information across the box, and note on the combination form that the declaration was used by the voter. Either you or the election judge should indicate on the "To Be Completed By Election Official" form what type of document the voter provided by checking the appropriate box. Either you or the election judge should fill in the Date of Election and Location fields.
- 5. Allow the voter to cast a regular ballot.

NOTE: This form may also be used if a voter voted provisionally and does not possess and cannot reasonably obtain an acceptable form of photo identification, and appears at the county voter registrar's office within six (6) calendar days after election day to execute a reasonable impediment declaration and present one of the supporting forms of identification, in accordance with Section 65.0541 of the Yexas Election Code. In that instance, the county voter registrar should follow steps 1 through 4 above, but substitute references to "election judge" with "county voter registrar", including signing where the election judge would otherwise sign on the space provided on the declaration.

How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge must fill out required information as follows:
 - Location of Polling Place
 - Date of Election
 - Type of Election
 - · Authority Conducting the election
 - Date
 - Signature of Presiding Judge
- 2. Checking in Voter:
 - Write Voter's VUID number
 - Write Voter's Name listed from Pollbook
 - Check the required box if applicable
 - Voter shall Sign and check proper box if applicable
- 3. Presiding Judge files, the copies in the following listed below:
 - Original is returned to the General Custodian in **Envelope No. 2.**
 - One copy is placed in <u>Ballot Box.</u>
 - One copy is retained by the Presiding Judge in <u>Envelope No. 3.</u>
 - One copy is returned to the Voter Registrar in <u>Envelope No. 4.</u>

<u>Note:</u> All voters are required to have some form of acceptable identification. When a voter is accepted for voting under certain conditions of the law, the election official shall note the section of the Texas Election Code under which the voter was accepted. The following are explanations of those conditions and the section numbers of the laws that correspond with the explanations.

- Scenario 1: Voter (with acceptable identification) with Correct Certificate Who is Not on List:
 - Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006" next to the voter's name.
 - Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List.
- Scenario 2: Voter (with acceptable identification) with Incorrect Certificate Who is Not on List:
 - Have voter initial the "Affidavit for Voter Not on List" box (near the voter's signature).
 - Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006."
 - Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List.
 - It is also necessary to indicate on the Registration Omissions List the precinct number as indicated on the voter's registration certificate.
- Scenario 3: Voter (with acceptable identification) whose Name on Identification is "Substantially Similar" to Name on the Official List of Registered Voters:
 - Have voter initial the "Similar Name Affidavit" box (near voter's signature).
 - Check the box labeled "Similar Name 63.001(c)."
- Scenario 4: If a voter is unable to sign his or her name, an election official shall place the voter's name on the signature roster and make a notation as to the reason the voter is unable to sign.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMBINATION FORM

All voters are required to have some form of acceptable identification. When a voter is accepted for voting under certain conditions of the law, the election official shall note the section of the Texas Election Code under which the voter was accepted. The following are explanations of those conditions and the section numbers of the laws that correspond with the explanations.

1. Voter (with acceptable identification) with Correct Certificate Who is Not on List:

Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006" next to the voter's name. Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List.

Voter (with acceptable identification) with Incorrect Certificate Who is Not on List:

Have voter initial the "Affidavit for Voter Not on List" box (near the voter's signature). Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006." Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List. It is also necessary to indicate on the Registration Omissions List the precinct number as indicated on the voter's registration certificate.

 Voter (with acceptable identification) whose Name on Identification is "Substantially Similar" to Name on the Official List of Registered Voters:

Have voter initial the "Similar Name Affidavit" box (near voter's signature). Check the box labeled "Similar Name 63.001(c)."

<u>Provisional Voting</u> — Follow your Authority of Conducting the Election for proper forms/e-pollbook that may be provided for these steps.

Affidavit of Provisional Voter Envelope: (see Texas Election Code 63.011)

Purpose: Allows Voter to vote and have the voter registration status checked later by the Voter Registrar.

Front side of Affidavit of Provisional Voter Envelope:

How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge will need to fill out the top providing the following items:
 - 1. Type of Election
 - 2.Precinct number/Polling Place where Voted
 - 3. Precinct number where voter is determined. (To determine this information, follow your Authority Conducting the Elections instructions to be able to provide the voters voting precinct number.)
 - 4.Date of Election

All information must be completed so that the appropriate voter's Application for Ballot by Mail or Federal Post Card Application can be cancelled.








- 1. The Presiding Judge shall issue Name Tags following the administration of the oath.
- 2. Workers will print their name legibly on the Name Tag and display on clothing for Voters to be able to identify them and their role clearly at the Polling Location.

Note: The presiding judge and clerks must wear a form of identification, prescribed by the Secretary of State, while on duty that indicates the person's name and title or position as an election officer. If there are no name tags in your election kit, you may make your own. (State and federal election inspectors, peace officers assigned to the polling place, and poll watchers accepted for service at the polling place are also required to wear name tags.)











Statement of Compensation and Oaths: (see Texas Election Codes 32.094, 62.003, 64.034)


Notice of Total Number of Voters Who Have Voted: (see Texas Election Code 61.007(c))

Purpose: Public Notice of voter turnout throughout Election Day.

How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge will fill out the following prior to posting:
 - Signature of Presiding Judge
- Presiding Judge will post at an outside door through which a voter may enter the building in which the polling place is located.
- Presiding Judge or Assigned Worker shall post the accumulative number of voters who have voted at the polling place the election is being held at the following listed times:
 - 9:30 a.m.
 - 11:30 a.m.
 - 1:30 p.m.
 - 3:30 p.m.
 - 5:30 p.m.
- 4. After polls close, the presiding judge will remove the posted Notice of Total Number of Voters Who Have Voted and file it to the general custodian of election records in **Envelope # 2.**

Note: If you missed the designated time to enter the voters who have voted, **best practice** should be to log the number of voters at the time you can and document the time it was recorded.





Register of Official Ballots:

Purpose: To account for all ballots received by Election Judges.

How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge shall verify the amount of all ballots received at supply pickup.
 - Number of Ballots documented should match what is physically verified.
 - Sequentially numbered ballots should match the Beginning # ____ to ___ on the form.
 - If any errors are found, the Presiding Judge shall Notify the authority conducting the
 election immediately. Presiding Judge shall write detailed documentation of situation
 that occurred and how it was corrected at the time of the occurrence. All
 documentation shall be dated and signed when the occurrence occurs.
- 2. Presiding Judge shall keep up with all ballots during election day, keeping a detailed log if any occurrences may arise.
- 3. Presiding Judge shall keep up with the following during election day to be able to record the following information at the end of night:
 - Number of Ballots defectively Printed
 - Number of Spoiled Ballots returned by voter
 - Number of unused ballots
 - Number of ballots voted including provisional
- 4. Presiding Judge will file Original in **Ballot Box # 4** with unused ballots, place other copy in **Envelope # 3** addressed to the presiding judge.

Note: If polling location runs out of ballots and the authority conducting issues more ballots, the new ballots will need to be documented on the form to maintain a correct count.

Note: If authority conducting election retrieves ballots from the polling location to transfer to another location, Presiding Judge shall document on form and provide detailed information supporting transfer of ballots being taken



How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge shall fill out the following:
 - Type of Election
 - Date of Election
 - · Precinct No. the Polling Place is Located
 - Authority Conducting Election
- 2. When Polls Close, Presiding Judge shall fill out the following information:
 - Record the Total Number of Voters who voted, as shown on poll list.
 - Record the Total number of thrown out / stray Ballots. (Example: Voter left their voted ballot somewhere other than the ballot scanner.)
 - Subtract lines 1 and 2 and record the number. This numbers should match the Precinct Ballot Counter.
 - Record the actual number of ballots counted from the precinct counter tape.
 - Record the total number of ballots placed in transfer case. (Same as line 1)
- Presiding Judge shall record the serial number(s) of the precinct ballot counter used at the polling place.
- 4. Presiding Judge shall record the seal number that was used to seal the transfer case to transport to election night headquarters.
- 5. Presiding Judge shall record date and sign verifying the information is correct.
- 6. Presiding Judge shall have at least one Election Clerk and not more than two Poll Watchers witness the form being filled out. Presiding Judge shall allow the Election Clerk and or (up to 2) Poll Watcher(s) sign the form if they were part of witnessing the process.
- Presiding Judge will file the certificate in the designated envelope to deliver with the transfer case of cast ballots. Do not put the form in the transfer case.



Note: If there is a difference of more than 3 ballots between line 3 and 4, the ballots are to be transferred to a central counting station to be counted.

Do not make out the Returns in this case.

Sign and attach a copy of the tape from the precinct ballot counter to the ballot and seal certificate. Place certificate in the envelope for ballot and seal certificate and deliver to the general custodian with the transfer case.

Purpose: To account for all ballots that were returned by voters as mismarked, damaged or otherwise spoiled.


How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge shall fill out the following:
 - Type of Election
 - Date of Election
 - Polling Location Precinct Number
 - Authority Conducting the Election
- 2. Presiding Judge shall print the Ballot Serial Number on the form.
- 3. Presiding Judge shall print the Name of the Voter on the form.
- 4. Presiding Judge shall check the reason of Spoiling the ballot. (Spoiled by Voter, Spoiled by Election Worker and Other (Ballot wouldn't scan or other administrative error) Note: If other is checked, a detailed written explanation of the reason would be recommended as a best practice.
- 5. Presiding Judge shall file the spoiled ballot in the **Envelope for Spoiled Ballots** once all required information is recorded.
- 6. Presiding Judge shall read the affidavit at the bottom of the form, date and sign certifying that the above information provided is true and correct.
- 7. Presiding Judge will file in <u>Ballot Box No. 4</u> or other designated container specified by the Authority Conducting the Election.

Notes:

- 1. If a voter destroys or makes a mistake on his/her ballot, he/she may return it in for a new one no more than two times for a total of 3 ballots.
- 2. The Presiding Judge keeps this record to account for the number of ballots given to each voter.
- 3. If a poll worker makes an administrative error, the voter does not lose one of his/her three ballots.

Secrecy Sleeve - When completing the spoiled ballot process, place the voter's ballot in a secrecy sleeve so that other person in the polling place may not see the voter's choices on the spoiled ballot. Exposing a voter's choices for others to see is not conducive to a secret ballot.



Registration Omissions List:

Purpose: To document voters who voted with a certificate who were not on the list (but who had required documentation); to advise the registrar of these omissions for further review by the registrar.

Note: Presiding Judge shall contact the Voter Registrar immediately for further instruction.

How To:

- 1. Presiding Judge shall fill out the following:
 - Type of Election
 - Precinct Number of the Assigned Polling Location
 - Date of Election
 - Authority Conducting the Election
- 2. The Election Worker shall write the following when processing the voter:
 - Precinct No. (From the Voter Registration Certificate/or determined from the Voter Registrar)
 - VUID No.
 - Voters Full Name (Last, First & Middle)
 - Complete Residence Address
 - Date of Birth
- 3. The Voter shall sign the combination form/ePollbook and be allowed to vote regular.
- Presiding Judge will file in <u>Envelope No. 4</u> to return to the Voter Registrar at the same time other election records are delivered.

Notes:

When a person is accepted for voting and his/her name is **not on the list** of registered voters or supplemental list of registered voters, the election officer must add the voter's name to the Registration Omissions List. The following are explanations of the law which allows for accepting a voter to vote whose name is not on the list.

- 1. Voter (with required documentation) with Correct Certificate Who is Not on List: On the combination form check the box labeled "Not on List 63,006" next to the voter's name. Add voter to Omissions List.
- 2. Voter (with required documentation) with Incorrect Certificate Who is Not on List: On the combination form, have voter initial the Voter's Affidavit "Not On List 63.006" box (near the voter's signature), and check the box labeled "Not On List 63.006." It is also necessary to indicate on the Omissions List the precinct number as indicated on the voter's certificate. Add voter's name to the Omissions List and check the box labeled "Not On List 63.006."

NOTE ABOUT AMENDMENTS: "Required documentation" refers to acceptable voter ID. or documentation showing an acceptable exemption. A voter without this documentation will vote provisionally (unless the voter chooses to return later with documentation). Prior law at Section 63.007 (Voter Not on List, Incorrect Certificate) is now (with minor revisions) one of two procedures in Section 63.006. Prior law at Section 63.009 (Voter Not on List, No Certificate) is no longer applicable; this voter will vote provisionally.
