

CANCELLING ELECTION

WHEREAS, Coats Rose, P.C., the attorney for Freedom Trail Municipal Utility District of Liberty County (the “District”), is the authority responsible for having the official ballot prepared for the District’s May 2, 2026, Directors Election (the “Election”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.052, Texas Election Code, as amended, Coats Rose, P.C. has certified in writing to the Board of Directors of the District that the candidates to be listed on the ballot for the Election are unopposed, i.e., only one candidate’s name will appear on the ballot for each open position and no candidate’s name will be placed on a list of write-in candidates for the office of director of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.053, Texas Election Code, as amended, the Board of Directors of the District has the authority to cancel the Election and declare unopposed candidates to be elected to office; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FREEDOM TRAIL MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF LIBERTY COUNTY THAT:

Section 1: The Board of Directors of the District hereby declares the following unopposed candidates to be elected to the office of director of the District:

- Jamie Heiland
- Ashley Leistad


The candidates declared elected to office shall serve until the directors election in the year 2030, or until their successors have been duly elected or appointed and have qualified.

Section 2: Each candidate declared elected to office under this Order shall enter into the duties of his/her office and shall begin to serve his/her term of office after May 2, 2026, and upon posting bond in the amount of \$10,000, upon taking the constitutional oath of office, and upon acceptance of the bond and oath of office by the District’s Board of Directors.

Section 3: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.053(b), Texas Election Code, as amended, the Election is cancelled and will not be held. A copy of this Order will be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.


Section 4: The President and Secretary of the District’s Board of Directors and Coats Rose, P.C. are hereby authorized and directed to take any action necessary to carry out the provisions of this Order

CONSIDERANDO QUE, Coats Rose, P.C., el abogado del Distrito Municipal de Servicios Públicos Freedom Trail del Condado de Liberty (el "Distrito"), es la autoridad responsable de preparar la papeleta oficial para la elección de directores del Distrito del 2 de mayo de 2026 (la "Elección"); y

QUE LA JUNTA DIRECTIVA DEL DISTRITO MUNICIPAL DE SERVICIOS PÚBLICOS FREEDOM TRAIL DEL CONDADO DE LIBERTY ORDENE QUE:

Sección 1: La Junta Directiva del Distrito declara por la presente que los siguientes candidatos sin oposición serán elegidos para el cargo de director del Distrito:

- Jamie Savior
- Ashley Leistad

Los candidatos declarados elegidos para el cargo ejercerán hasta la elección de directores en el año 2030, o hasta que sus sucesores hayan sido debidamente elegidos o nombrados y hayan cumplido los requisitos.

Sección 2: Cada candidato declarado electo bajo esta Orden asumirá las funciones de su cargo y comenzará a cumplir su mandato después del 2 de mayo de 2026, y tras la presentación de una fianza por un importe de 10.000 dólares, tras tomar el juramento constitucional y aceptar la fianza y el juramento por la Junta Directiva del Distrito.

Sección 3: De acuerdo con las disposiciones de la Sección 2.053(b) del Código Electoral de Texas, según su enmienda, la elección queda cancelada y no se celebrará. Una copia de esta Orden se colocará el día de las elecciones en cada colegio electoral que se hubiera utilizado en la elección.

Sección 4: El Presidente y el Secretario de la Junta Directiva del Distrito y Coats Rose, P.C. están autorizados y dirigidos a tomar cualquier acción necesaria para cumplir con las disposiciones de esta Orden
