

Commissioners Court Order Extending a Local State of Disaster

WHEREAS, the County of Liberty has suffered widespread damage or there is an imminent threat of same, to life, health, and property resulting from:

Flooding/Tropical Storm Imelda

AND, thousands residents within Liberty County have impacted from this event,


AND, that several residents remain in local shelters, while many homes suffered serve damage

WHEREAS, the Liberty County Commissioners' Court has determined that extraordinary measures may need to be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and protect or rehabilitate property, county roads, and county facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF
THE COUNTY OF LIBERTY:

1. That the Local State of Disaster issued by County Judge Jay Knight on September 19, 2019 and filed on September 19, 2019 and extended on September 26, 2019 in a special meeting, be continued until terminated by the Liberty County Commissioners Court;
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan remain implemented;
3. That the Liberty County Commissioners Court review the status of the emergency declaration at the next regular session of commissioners court on October 8, 2019.
4. That this order shall take effect immediately after its issuance.
