ORDER AUTHORIZING 4<sup>TH</sup> OF JULY FIREWORKS SALES


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Liberty County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of 4<sup>th</sup> of July; and

WHEREAS, on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 2023, the Commissioners Court of Liberty County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Liberty County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the 4<sup>th</sup> of July period **beginning June 24, 2023 and ending at midnight July 4, 2022**, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as "skyrockets with sticks" under 49 C.F.R. part 143.100 (r)(2)(10-86 edition) or missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of Liberty County
- b. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, July 4, 2023, whichever is earlier.
- c. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C Misdemeanor.
- d. This order is in effect from June 24, 2023 through midnight July 4, 2023.
