The below modifications/clarifications supersede the original specifications, issued on April 11, 2024.

1) **3.** General, h) Additional Requirements of Vendor if Awarded – Item 2

<u>Did Read</u>: All orders for materials or work must be authenticated by a Purchase Order issued by the Liberty County Purchasing Department. Invoices not bearing a Purchase Order number will not be paid.

Should Read: Departments will issue a Purchase Order to the Contractor on an as needed basis. No work may commence unless the Contractor has received a Purchase Order and bonding requirements, if any have been provided to Liberty County Purchasing for that specific project.

2) To be added as Item 7 to Additional Requirements of Vendor if Awarded

BONDING: Any required bonds will be provided at the Bidder's expense and should be included in your bid price. The Performance and Payment Bonds shall be provided by Contractor to Liberty

County Purchasing not later than the 10th day after a Purchase Order has been issued, but in any case, before the start of any work.

Bid Bond - No bid bond is required. Do not submit a Bid Bond with your offer.

<u>Performance Bond</u> - If applicable, a Performance Bond shall be required. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2253.021 of the Texas Government Code, if the amount of the contract awarded to the successful bidder exceeds \$100,000.00, the successful bidder shall execute a performance bond in the amount of the contract. Said performance bond is solely for the protection of Liberty County and is conditioned on the faithful performance of the work in accordance with the plans and contract documents.

<u>Payment Bond</u> - If applicable, a Payment Bond shall be required. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2253.021, Texas Government Code, if the amount of the contract awarded to the successful bidder exceeds \$25,000.00, the successful bidder shall execute a payment bond in the amount of the contract. Said bond is solely for the protection and use of payment bond beneficiaries who have a direct contractual relationship with the prime contractor or a subcontractor to supply public work labor or material.

The due date remains April 25, 2024. Submission deadline is 10:00 a.m. Proposals will be opened at 10:00 a.m. and the names of the respondents will be read aloud.
