What To Do When A Hurricane Threatens

- Find the risk area where you live and note its area label (a letter and a number such as L5).
- Find this label on the chart below to get an estimate of your travel time should you have to evacuate. Remember this is only the time to get beyond the threatened risk areas, not to a shelter location or your final destination.
- If you live near a risk area line or are unsure of your risk area, use the evacuation information for the area nearest the coast.
- If you live on a barrier island, on the coast, in a mobile home near the coast, or in low-lying or flood-prone areas near the coast, plan to evacuate any time a storm threatens.
- If you will be traveling with young children, older family members or people with special needs, and you can leave early, do so.
- When local officials tell you to evacuate, do so immediately.
