#### **Pipeline Permit Information**

- A Liberty County pipeline permit is required for new or repair construction
- A permit may be secured by contacting the Permit Department at the above shown phone number
- There are no special forms that are needed. The permit receipt will serve as evidence that a permit has been secured.
- The cost for a pipeline permit is \$3,000.00 and is payable prior to any construction
- The pipeline permit covers road crossings (must be bored) and culvert fees

County road use to access pipeline right-of-way is a negotiated item that must be handled directly with the Precinct Commissioner whose area is being crossed. This is an upfront fee that is payable prior to construction starting.

Contact with the appropriate Commissioner is required as it will be necessary for the pipeline owner to disclose county roads that will be used to access the pipeline rights of way. This information will be used by the Commissioner to determine anticipated road damages arising from said use. This predetermined damage amount must be remitted to Liberty County prior to commencing construction. In addition to predetermined damages, the pipeline owner must purchase a "pipeline permit". The cost of this permit is \$ 3,000.00 and an application form is attached. To secure a pipeline permit, the applicant should contact the Liberty County Permitting Department as shown below:
